



RESIDENCY POLICY

- I. The primary mission of the Washington County Library is to provide open and equal access of ideas and information to all residents of the community. In accordance with Utah State law, a resident is anyone who resides in any area of Washington County which is taxed for county library service.

- II. In addition, individuals who reside outside the Library's taxing jurisdiction, but who own property that is taxed by the Washington County Library are also considered residents for purposes of receiving library services. The rights and privileges established under the policies of the Washington County Library are reserved for residents as herein defined, except as provision is made by the Board of Directors to extend services to non-residents.
