## 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Video Contest Rules

- 1. The contest is open to Washington County residents, and residents living in communities with contractual library privileges such as Colorado City, Beryl Junction, etc. College students who maintain Washington County residency may enter. The entry should relate to the contest theme "A Century of Stories."
- **2.** Work published previously in any copyrighted newspaper, magazine, book or other medium is ineligible. Entries must be original.
- **3.** Contestants may enter one video submission in their age group. Age groups are as follows: Elementary Students, Intermediate Students, High School Students, and Adults.
- **4.** Each submission requires a completed entry form, with current contact information. To facilitate blind judging, the contestants name must only appear on the entry form. Submissions should follow these guidelines:
  - Family friendly
  - 30-60 seconds long
- **5.** Submit your video no later than 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 31, 2019. To submit your video, please use the following steps:
  - 1. Set up an account on YouTube.com (if you don't already have a YouTube account)
  - 2. Upload your video to YouTube
  - 3. In the upload properties set your video to "unlisted" if you do not want it to be publicly searchable
  - 4. Include the hashtag #100YearsIfStGLibrary (or whatever you come up with) in the title and use this hashtag if the video is shared on social media
  - 5. Wait for the upload to finish
  - 6. Email the URL of the YouTube video to: <a href="mailto:jlarson@washco.lib.ut.us">jlarson@washco.lib.ut.us</a>
  - 7. Email a completed entry form to: <u>jlarson@washco.lib.ut.us</u>
- **6.** No submissions will be returned.
- **7.** Panels, writers, journalists and teachers will judge. (Teachers will not judge their own students' entries.) A separate panel of judges will select the Grand Prize winner. Judging and winner notification will be completed by the end of July, and announced in August.
- **8.** All contestants agree to allow Washington County Library System to use the entries in print and online editions. Winners may be asked to provide a photo to appear with their entries.
- **9.** The decisions of the judges are final. Submission indicates acceptance of all contest rules.
