## Message From The Director

What is the future of the library? A commissioner asked me this question recently. Allow me to break out my crystal ball, don my gypsy hat, and describe for you the future.

Looking into my crystal ball, the future of the library, in my opinion, is beautiful. I see a new library somewhere along the southern border of St. George. We are saving for this now, and hope it is not too distant in the future. I see the library as a community center. What if the library shared a building with a rec center? What if the library shared space with the Senior Citizen Center? What if the library had a performance arts center, for recitals, plays, performances, and more? What if the library had programs off site (school, park, sand hollow, quail creek, Snow Canyon, the movie theater, etc.)?

Also in my crystal ball, I see technology playing a bigger role. Right now, we have self-checkout as an additional option for patrons. I think the future might look more like the grocery store, where self-checkout is the primary option, with a staff member available to help where needed. I see an app where people can have their library card on their phone, and might even be able to checkout with the phone instead of even visiting a self-checkout computer. Right now, we circulate over 1M physical books a year, and about 300K ebooks a year. We will always have physical books, but the future will probably be more like 50/50 in electronic availability and usage.

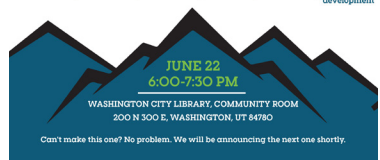

The Collaborative Summer Library Program (CSLP) is a consortium of states working together to provide high-quality summer reading program materials for children, teens, and adults for their public libraries. Best of all, every program is FREE to our patrons!

This year, the Library System offers reading programs for children, 'tweens, teens and adults! The theme for 2022 is "Oceans of Possibilities", and features programming with a focus on water.

Why read? Successful readers generally do better at school, and are more successful taking tests. Summer is an important time for students to keep reading and improve their language skills. If your child doesn't read regularly this summer, they may be in danger of the "summer slide" - a decline in their reading ability.

Studies have shown that children and teens that read regularly during the summer retain their reading skills, and are more likely to do well in school. Reading is also great for grown-ups! Reading helps slow cognitive decline in adults. And reading is fun, so get the whole family signed up to read this summer.

## READ DOWN YOUR FINES!

Children age 17 and under can read down their library fines at any of the library branches from JUNE 1 - JULY 30, 2022. Children must come to the library to read down their fines. Each 15 minutes they read takes one dollar off the fine!

To take advantage of this program, children must check in with library staff. The start and finish times will be documented and the fines removed from their library record when finished!

Library fines may be read down on adult records if the late fines are from the children's collection. Only fines can be waived, lost or damaged items are not included in this program. Check it out @ your library!
