I'm please to share several new and improved resources available at the library for patron use:

RBDigital - Many people know about and use Overdrive/Libby. However, did you know that we have a database for just e-audiobooks? We have continued to grow our e-audiobook selection in RBDigital, but we have just signed a new deal with AMAZING benefits for our e-audiobook listeners. Our holdings for e-audiobooks jumped from 500 items to over 28,000. Jaw dropping, right? Even better, for the majority of the content, there are no holds and simultaneous checkout. Checkout what you want, when you want. Find RBDigital in our ebook section of our e-resources on our website.

Reference USA – We had access to Reference USA through the state, but discontinued providing the resource. However, back by popular demand, we have contracted (with Dixie University) to provide this reference and research info to our patrons. With information on U.S. Business (including local), New Businesses, white pages, Jobs, internships, healthcare, consumers, and more...it is a great addition to the library! Wanna look up an old friend...I did. Find Reference USA in our database section of our e-resources on our website.

Makerspaces – The library has been adding Makerspaces at each branch. Santa Clara, St. George, and Hurricane were the first. We've just been approved (and have purchased most of the equipment) to build a new extension of the Washington Branch for an A/V Makerspace. Want to do a podcast, make a movie with a green screen, record a record...it will all be doable in the Washington A/V Makerspace. Also, we have just purchased a mobile makerspace for each of our small branches. With tech gadgets to tinker with, a 3D printer, and Virtual Reality headsets, we are excited to have these available to all who are interested.



Virtual Reality (VR) - Each branch now has at least one Oculus VR headset and one Merge Augmented Reality Headset. Want to travel the world, learn Tai Chi, meditate, do puzzles, become a DJ, visit a museum, or train to use a light saber? Come visit the library, we've got you covered!


